

Check a license order (v2)

 This page refers to **End-user REST API version 2** only. See [End-user REST API](#) for links to other versions of the End-user REST API.

To check the status of a license order for a given activation key using the End-user REST API version 2, use the following request:

```
HEAD /license-orders/{activation_key}
```

where:

- `activation_key` (string) is your [license order](#) activation key

and

- the [request headers](#) are used by default

Note: This method returns the same status codes as GET, but without the body. It is used for checking the state/availability of a license order.

Example request

```
HEAD /rest/v2/license-orders/25N8D-NC35D-WD01P-8JI4K HTTP/1.1
Host: license.x-formation.com
Accept: application/hal+json
```

Response

The following table lists the Internet status codes that can be returned in a response by a server.

Status Code	Header Field	Description
200 OK	• Allow • Cache-Control • Content-Encoding • Content-Language • Content-Length • Content-Type • Date	License order details.
403 Forbidden		License order has been disabled.
404 Not Found		License order was not found.

Example responses

```
HTTP/1.1 200 OK
Content-Type: application/hal+json
```

```
HTTP/1.1 403 Forbidden
Content-Type: application/hal+json
```

```
HTTP/1.1 404 Not Found
Content-Type: application/hal+json
```
