

System requirements

The information on this page refers to License Statistics v6.20 or newer, which removed support for Windows Server 2012 R2. If you are using an earlier version, please refer to the [documentation for earlier versions](#).

The supported platforms and hardware requirements for running License Statistics are detailed below.

Supported platforms

License Statistics is supported on the following Windows and Linux distributions.
