

LDAP issues

Logging into License Statistics using manager account credentials from LDAP

When trying to log into License Statistics using credentials (username and password) that are the same as credentials specified for your Manager DN and Manager Password in the LDAP tab in the **Administration** page, ensure that the manager account is included in the Base DN (for example, CN=Users, DC=yourdomain, DC=com) under which you want to search for users or, preferably, create a separate account to authenticate with LDAP.

Example

Say you set Manager DN to “demo-user” and Manager Password (here hidden as asterisks) to “statistics”.
