

Nillable attributes

All elements in SOAP have a nillable attribute that is set to true; for example:

```
<result_string xsi:nil="true"/>
```

You should handle nillable attributes appropriately, depending on the programming language you are using.

Programming Language	Results
C#	Elements with the type int and the attribute nillable set to true are given the type "int?". You should typecast this to "int" when using the variables. For example: Soap_Response_LicenseOrder RLO = c.GetLicenseOrderTemplate(L.token, (int) PL.result_array[0].ProductTemplates[0].id);
Java	Elements with the type int and the attribute nillable set to true are changed to an instance of class Integer.
