

Standard enumerated columns

The information on this page refers to License Statistics v6.11 and newer, which redesigned license server administration, resulting in replacing gathering type with multiple data sources. If you are using a version previous to v6.11, see [documentation for previous versions](#).

The License Statistics API includes the standard enumerated columns described below.

Feature type

Describes how license is obtained.

License type	How license is obtained
Floating	License is checked out from license server. When one user checks the license in (stops using it), another can check it out.
Node-locked	License is bound to HostID.
Token	Similar to Floating license type, but several features share a common token pool . Each feature can require a different number of tokens from the token pool for license checkout.

Granularity

For historic reports, describes that data should be grouped by some period of time.

Granularity	Type and format
QUARTER	Year and quarter; e.g., "2019-Q2."
MONTH	Year and month; e.g., "2019-10."
WEEK	Week defined by a span of two dates joined by a dash; e.g., "2019-05-13-2019-05-19."
DAY	Date; e.g., "2019-01-01."
HOURL	Date and time; e.g., "2019-01-02 17:05."

License server status

Describes state of license server.

Status	Description
ONLINE	Everything is OK.
OFFLINE	Querying failed.
VERIFYING	License server was recently enabled or changed, and has not been queried since then.
DISABLED	License server is disabled by user.
LICSTAT_DOWN	Used in historic report to denote times when the entire License Statistics application was turned off.
LICENSE_EXCEEDED	License server is automatically disabled due to licensing limitations.
